As per Dr. Radhakrishnan Committee recommendations, NAAC has proposed to launch the Basic (Binary) Accreditation followed by Maturity-Based Graded Levels (MBGL) Accreditation.

HEIs accredited under RAF (Revised Accreditation Framework) whose validity was set to expire or likely to expire during the period between 27th January 2024 and date of launch of Maturity Based Graded Levels (MBGL) Accreditation shall be extended for a maximum period of three months after the launch of MBGL Accreditation. Such HEIs may also opt for Basic Accreditation to be launched soon.

However, such HEIs should continue to maintain and improve quality through their IQAC cells.
