A consistent code would be followed, which starts with VAC followed by department code followed by numeric value, e.g. VAC ME 101. The duration of such courses should be at least 30 hours, which may be any combinations of theory and practice.

(b) Identifications of courses that focuses on employability, entrepreneurship etc.

The department should study the syllabus carefully and identify the appropriate courses which typically focuses on employability, entrepreneurship etc. and accordingly provide data in the given template.

(c) Status of courses/programs on life skills such as aptitude, communication, computer languages etc.

In addition to T & P cell, individual department will also take initiatives for execution of such courses

(d) Feedback collection from different stake holders and analysis for the year 2021-22.

The collected feedback from different stake holders will be analyzed meticulously and incorporate the suggestions for improvement, if any. The report would be placed in the next meeting of Academic council for approval.
