1. Fee Payment Obligations

- Attendance in the Students' Induction Programme (SIP) and Orientation Programme is compulsory, and absence without prior written approval from the competent authority will be treated as non-compliance.

2. Hostel Allotment

- Hostel allotment will be made only upon production of the fee receipt and other required documents (admission letter, medical fitness certificate, recent passport-size photographs, and ID proof).

3. Document Verification

- Secondary (10th) and Higher Secondary (12th) Mark Sheets
- Migration Certificate (if applicable)
- Aadhaar Card / Valid ID Proof
- Failure to produce required documents may lead to withholding of hostel allotment and registration for classes until compliance is met.

4. Discipline & Conduct

- Any involvement in alcohol, drugs, physical fighting, or ragging will result in immediate expulsion from hostel and institute, cancellation of admission, and possible police action under applicable laws.
- Students shall abide by all hostel and Institute rules from the date of reporting.
- Any act of indiscipline during induction/orientation or in the hostel premises will invite strict disciplinary action, including possible cancellation of hostel accommodation.

5. Consequences of Non-Compliance

- Non-reporting on the scheduled date without prior written approval shall be treated as a violation of admission obligations.
- Students failing to report or complete registration within seven (7) days from the commencement date may face cancellation of admission/hostel allotment, as deemed appropriate by the competent authority.

HOSTEL ALLOTMENT PROCEDURE AND GUIDELINES ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26

All B.Tech. 1st Year (1st Semester) students of Haldia Institute of Technology who have opted for hostel facilities are hereby informed of the following procedure and guidelines regarding hostel allotment, payment of fees, and code of conduct:

1. Hostel Allotment & Online Portal Access

- The process of hostel opting, room selection, and payment shall commence on 07.09.2025 through the official portal: <http://student.hithaldia.in>.
- Each student can select hostel accommodation and available rooms through this portal.
- Login credentials (login as existing student) have already been communicated via SMS to the registered mobile numbers of students who opted for hostel facilities at the time of admission.

2. Fee Structure & Payment Process

- The total fee payable for the First Semester is ₹17,000/-, which includes the refundable Caution Money Deposit.
- Payment shall be made exclusively through the online portal: <http://student.hithaldia.in>.
- Upon successful payment, students must download the Hostel Allotment Letter from the Dashboard option on the portal.
- Hostel accommodation will be granted on 14.09.2025 only upon production of the Hostel Allotment Letter downloaded from the portal.

- The use of motorbikes/scooters, and electrical appliances (e.g., induction cookers, heaters, high-power devices) inside the hostels or campus is strictly prohibited.
- Violation of this rule will attract disciplinary action, including forfeiture of hostel facilities.

The Caution Money shall be refunded only after the student has vacated the hostel, after completion of course subject to:

- Clearance of all dues.
- Satisfactory handover of hostel property without damage.
- Compliance with hostel rules and regulations during stay.
- Refunds will be made only through bank transfer to the student/parent's account and not in cash.

3. Hostel Fee & Revision Clause

- The hostel fee shall be payable annually in advance, unless otherwise notified.
- The Institute/ICARE reserves the right to revise hostel charges (including mess, electricity, maintenance, and allied services) from time to time in accordance with inflation, regulatory guidelines, and actual cost escalations.

- Residents are personally liable for damages caused by them, recoverable from their caution money or through direct billing.

5. Attendance & Academic Compliance

- Hostel residency is conditional upon maintaining minimum attendance requirements as prescribed by the affiliating University / AICTE norms.
- Any student falling short of attendance, or found habitually absent without permission, may forfeit hostel privileges.
- Hostel facility is provided solely for bonafide students attending classes and academic activities regularly.

6. Other Important Clauses

- Hostel allotment is non-transferable and is valid only for the allotted student.
- Visitors and guests are permitted strictly as per rules and timings notified by the Warden.
- The Society/Institute shall not be liable for loss/theft of personal belongings; residents are advised to take due care.
- Any dispute relating to hostel matters shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the competent courts at Haldia, West Bengal.
